

License Agreement

This License Agreement, hereinafter referred to as the License, constitutes a legal agreement between the Licensee and the Licensor, Websoft Zbiniew Giza.

1. The subject of the agreement is granting by the Licensor of a License for the mypages.pl computer software under the conditions described hereinafter.
2. The Licensee is a natural person, a legal entity or an unincorporated organizational entity, who has purchased the License to the software mentioned above and is entitled to use it.
3. The Licensor grants the Licensee a perpetual, non-exclusive License to the software mentioned above.
4. The software includes libraries made by third parties, made available under an open license. These libraries have been used in accordance with the provisions of respective license agreements under which they had been made public.
5. The Licensor declares that it is the author of the software, excluding the libraries mentioned in clause 4. For this reason, the Licensor is entitled to the copyrights resulting from the Act on Copyrights and Related Rights of 4 February 1994.
6. If any defects are observed in the operation of the software, the Licensor shall endeavour to eliminate them.
7. The Licensor shall not be held liable for any possible damage arising from the use of the software.
8. The Licensor shall transfer to the Licensee the right to use the software within a single domain. Use of the software on more than one domain requires purchase of an additional license.
9. The Licensee has no right to distribute copies of the software or fragments of the source code thereof, both in the current and modified form.
10. The Licensee undertakes to store the software safely, in a manner preventing copying of source files by third parties.
11. The Licensor permits own modifications of the software. Introduction of modifications which result in incorrect operation of mechanisms checking the legality of the license is prohibited. All copyright information contained in the source code of the software and in the administrative panel must remain unchanged.
12. The Licensee has the right to assign (transfer) the property rights to the owned license. Upon the transfer of these rights, the Licensee loses the right to own and use this software. Before the transfer of the property rights, the Licensee is obliged to report this fact to the Licensor, indicating the license key as well as the personal data of the current and future owner of the license. The Licensee is obliged to pass the present License Agreement, along with the license key, to the purchaser.
13. If the software is launched on a server without using an attached installer, the Licensee is obliged to give the Licensor the address under which it has been launched.

14. The Licensee has the right to change the domain to which the license key is assigned. Such change shall be possible upon sending an application to the Licensor, containing the application key and the address of the new domain. Upon receiving the application, the Licensor shall make the appropriate modification.

15. The Licensee is obliged to comply with the provisions of this Agreement. Non-compliance with these provisions may result in withdrawal of the Licensor's permission. Serious infringements of this Agreement, such as distribution of the software, will result in initiation of a civil and/or criminal proceeding.

16. The law applicable to this Agreement shall be the law of Poland; in all matters not governed by the present Agreement, the provisions of the Polish Civil Code shall apply. All disputes shall be examined by Polish courts.
